

Sensory Friendly and Autism Friendly Movie

I am going to the Library to watch a movie.


A library is a building filled with books and magazines I can borrow.






I walk through the Library.


I may use the steps or the elevator to go upstairs or downstairs.






I walk to the meeting room.


My companions and I check in with the Library staff.






My companions and I find a place to sit.


I can sit on a chair or on the rug.





We can start eating the snacks we brought.


I only eat my snacks and I do not share my snacks with others.






I eat my snacks only in the meeting room.


The Library staff makes an announcement.


Some of the lights go off. Then the movie begins.




If I need to walk around, I can. I make sure I do not block the movie screen.




I am quiet during the movie.




If I need to go to the bathroom, I can get up and use the bathroom.
